1. READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING

2 Cautions before installation

1. NOTE THE FOLLOWING IMPORTANT POINTS

- 1. Do not install in a location where water might be splashed on this appliance or in a location exposed to such excessive moisture that condensation forms on the products surface.
- To avoid damage to electronic components due to high levels of humidity, provide adequate ventilation by opening a window and/or door when bathing. You may find operating an exhaust ventilating fan during these times of high humidity beneficial.
- 3. Use a water supply having a water pressure of 15 PSI -100 PSI.
- 4. Connect the product to a pipe carrying potable water. Do not connect to an industrial water line or other water supply that does not carry water of drinking quality.
- 5. In areas where water freezes in pipes in winter make arrangements to keep the pipes warm. The water remaining in the unit may sometimes freeze during storage in winter. In that case, warm the unit in the room before installation.



Ground Fault interrupt(GFI) outlets are mandated by electrical code. GFI outlets should be tested monthly to ensure correct operation. Please see GFI manufacturer instructions for more information.

3. This product is for use on a nominal 120V circuit, 3 prong Ground Fault Interrupt(GFI) outlet as illustrated in sketch A.



4 How to use UB-6035R

***Caution**

- Do not drop a remote control in water. It may cause malfunction.
- All functions will be operational when the seat sensor is activated, except Nozzle Cleaning
- Before operating, ensure that water tank is filled up completely.

Stop

- Press "Stop" to stop current operation.
- When a user stands up, all operations will stop automatically.

Cleansing

- Press "Cleansing" to clean your posterior. The function will stop in 60 seconds automatically.
- Press this button again to activate oscillation. The nozzle moves back and forth automatically to widen cleansing area.
- Oscillation wash stops if this button is pressed again.

Bidet

- Press "Bidet" for feminine wash. The function will stop in 60 seconds automatically.
- Press this button again to activate oscillation. The nozzle moves back and forth automatically to widen cleansing area.
- Oscillation wash stops if this button is pressed again.

Dry


- Press "Dryer" after "Cleansing" or "Bidet". Warm air will operate out for 3 minutes.
- To alter the air dry temperature press this button again.

IIP (intensive impulse pulsation)

- Press "IIP" for impluse pulsation massage spray.
- -The function will stop in 60 seconds automatically.
- Press "IIP" again to change the pulsation mode.

Kids

- Press " Kids" to change all functions for children.
- 1 minute for oscillation and 3 minutes for dry, level 1 water pressure and level 5 nozzle position will be set.
- This unit should be used under the supervision of an adult.



Air (aerated spray)

- Press "Air" to use aerated wash to clean. Gentle, delicate but strong water spray will save water consumption.
- Press this button again to release this function.
- "Cleansing" mode starts with this function on.

Water pressure / Dry temperature - Press ▼ • ♠ arrows to adjust water pressure. 5 levels.

- Press ▼· ♠ arrows to adjust dry temperature, 5 levels.
- Both levels default to 3.

Auto

- Press" Auto" during "Cleansing" operation. Wash, osciallation and dry will each operate for 20 seconds.
- For Auto Bidet, press "Bidet" and "Auto" consecutively.

Pulsation (massage)

- Press "Pulsation" to activate massage wash effect.
- Press "Pulsation" again to release this function.

Nozzle position

- Nozzle position can be adjusted 5 levels.
- Press arrows to adjust.
- Position default to level 3.

Economy

- Press " Economy" to activate power saving function.
- In Economy mode, water and seat temperatures are kept to 30 degrees celsius.
- Bulb on the remote control and green light on the main unit panel
- When the unit is next used, temperatures will revert to default
- Unit will revert to Economy mode after 1 hour of last use.
- Press "Economy" again to release this function. Red light will appear on the main unit panel.

Temperature adjustment (water / seat)

- Press "Water" or "Seat" buttons to adjust temperatures. 4 levels-room temperature, 34, 37, 40 degrees celsius.

Nozzle cleaning

- Ensure seat sensor is not activated.
- Press "Cleaning" button to clean posterior nozzle manually
- Press "Cleaning" button again to clean feminine nozzle manually.
- Press "Stop" to return nozzle to stand-by mode Refer to "How to clean" notes.

Time setting

- Time on the remote control is in 24 hours mode.
- To set the hour, press "Time" once and press ♥ ♠.
- Press"Time" again to set the minutes.
- Time will be re-set(DD:DD) if batteries are changed.

Automatic deodorization (If equipped)

- Deodorizer works automatically when appliance is in use. (max 20 minutes)
- Stops 60 seconds after use.

Self cleaning

- Nozzle self cleans before and after each use.






Main unit panels

- For use if remote control batteries are dead
- To turn off the unit, press "Power/ Bidet"

Identification

- Use this function when there is more than one unit of this product installed.
- To prevent interference among units, main unit and remote control should be set with the same ID.
- If there is only one unit in the bathroom, you do not need to set ID.
- Initial ID of remote control and main unit is "0". (¡¡;;;;;;;) There are $16 \text{ ID} (0 \sim 15)$



How to set ID

Remote control

- Press "Stop" for 5 seconds and Id: 00 shows up in display.
- Press → until your ID appears in display. (00 ~ 15)
- Press "Stop" again to set ID, and display will return to stand-by mode.

Main unit

- Plug in unit while pressing "Power/Bidet" on the main unit panel unti unit beeps.
- Change ID by pressing "Cleansing/Stop".
- Press "Power/Bidet" again to set ID

Note

- If IDs of remote control and main unit are different, main unit will not work.
- ID will be re-set (''a: ''D'') if the power is unplugged or batteries of remote are replaced.



Nozzle cleaning




Do not forcefully push or pull the nozzles, or bend them. It may result in failure. Caution Make sure to use "Cleaning" button on the remote control.

- Ensure seat sensor is not activated.
- Press "FR" button to clean posterior nozzle manually. Press "BK" button to clean feminine nozzle manually.

Press "Cleaning" button to clean posterior nozzle manually. Press this button again to clean feminine nozzle manually.


- Use a toothbrush or soft cloth to clean nozzles. Press "Stop", "FR" "BK" to return nozzle to stand-by mode. For extended cleaning, unplug for safety.
- Do not retract nozzles without a nozzle tip. It may result in malfunction.
- 5 Be sure nozzle tips are correctly in place.

Strainer maintenance

This appliance will not operate properly if the strainer is clogged. Be sure to clean the strainer regularly.



Cleaning the body

- Regularly wipe off the body with a soft cloth or sponge
- Remove the lid.
 - 1. Raise lid slightly forward. Pull left hinge out and up.
 - 2. Release the right hinge Never force soft close lid or seat to close.
- Do not clean this unit with toilet bowl cleaner or any abrasive chemicals. Use only a mild, neutral soap.
- Alway unplug unit when cleaning.







Preventing freezing

Make sure the power cord is plugged in properly.



- Set water temperature to low or middle.

 If the washroom is not heated, wrap water hoses with cloth.
- If unit will not be used for extended notice or if risk of freeze.
- If unit will not be used for extended period, or if risk of freezing. unplug and drain the water from the water tank and pipes thoroughly.
 - Refer to draining water method.

7 How to install



Do not plug in until installation is finished completely.

If electric work is needed, contact to a qualified electrician.

Remove the existing toilet lid and seat


- 1. Remove the nuts, washers and cone packings from the toilet seat mounting bolts in the back of the toilet.
- 2. Remove the toilet seat, lid and mounting bolts.
- 3. Keep them in case installing again.


Installation

Place the plate and guides over each mounting hole. Insert the mounting bolts through the plate and mounting holes, and slide cone packings and washers onto the bolts.




Toilet size (elongated & round front)

Seat sensor


- This appliance is equipped with a seat sensor.
- Unit will not work unless seat is occupied.



Check that all 4 seat pads are resting on ceramic bowl. If there is a gap 1/8" or greater, attach the spacers to seat pads.

Installation of remote control unit (UB-6035R)

How to Insert batteries




- 1. Open the battery lid of remote control and insert 3 AAA batteries into battery compartment.
- 2. Check the display appears properly.
- 3. Check the remote control works properly while seat is occupied.
- 4. Install the remote control bracket on the wall as shown below.


Note following precautions to prevent ruptured batteries and battery acid leakage.

- Use 3 AAA batteries only.
- Do not use old and new batteries together and same type of batteries only.
- Make sure that all batteries are inserted into their correct positions.
- Remove the batteries if the remote control is not used for a long time.
- LCD will fade or blink if the batteries reach the end of their life. Change the batteries immediately.
- Settings (time, power saving mode) will be lost when batteries are replaced.






Recommended position of attachment

Trial operation

1. Preparation

Plug the power cord into GFI outlet.

Press "BIDET" or "CLEANSING", Main unit water tank will fill in 2 minutes.

Sound indicates main unit water tank is full.

2. Test

Cover the toilet bowl with plastic sheet to catch spray.

Press down lightly over seat sensor to activate.

Check for all functions.

All units are factory tested before shipping. there may still be some water present in the lines.

8 Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible cause	Solution
Completely fails to work	Is there power to the outlet? Is the cord unplugged? Are you sitting on the seat?	Check for outlet breaker or GFI failure. Plug the power cord in properly. Sit on the seat to activate seat sensor.
Water does not spray	Is the water shutoff valve closed? Is the strainer clogged? Are the nozzles clogged?	Turn on water shutoff valve. Clean the strainer. Clean the nozzles.
Water is leaking or dripping	Check all hoses are tightened properly	If water is still leaking or dripping, contact authorized distributor.
Seat, water or air is not enough warm	Is the temperature set to OFF? Is appliance in economy mode? Freezing temperature?	Reset the temperature. Release the economy function. See page 11.
